The broad, nutty flavors of this wine show yeast autolysis while still tasting fresh. It's marked by cool, peach-skin flavor and the dry nuttiness of rolled oats. For a meaty fish sautéed with almonds.

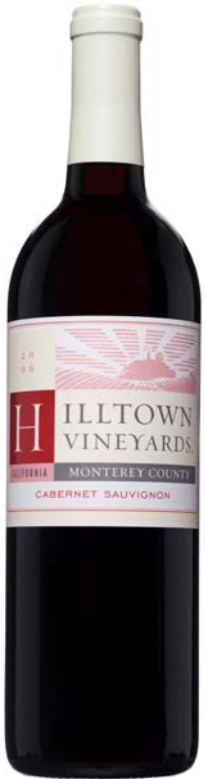
